Royal Assent

Be it known on this day at 1:30 p.m., the Speaker (D. Bennett) and the Clerk of the House of Assembly (S. Barnes), attended upon the Lieutenant Governor at Government House.

The Speaker addressed the Lieutenant Governor as follows:
