1. Government House Leader – To move:

Be it resolved by the House of Assembly as follows:

**WHEREAS** subsection 3(2) of the *Citizens' Representative Act* provides that the Citizens' Representative is to be appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council on a resolution of the House of Assembly;

**AND WHEREAS** section 5 of the Act states that a commissioner may be reappointed;

**AND WHEREAS** the appointment of the current commissioner, Bradley Moss expires on April 30;

**AND WHEREAS** it is proposed that Bradley Moss be reappointed as the commissioner for a term of 6 years;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** Bradley Moss be appointed as the Citizens' Representative for a term of 6 years.

**WHEREAS** subsection 6(3) of the *Independent Appointments Commission Act* provides that members of the Independent Appointments Commission are to be appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council on a resolution of the House of Assembly;
