In the space between the celling tiles and the roof, there were no building materials noted that would provide a substrate for microbial growth. Based on what was observed, mold is not considered to be a concern at this time. With that being said, any active leaks (e.g. in the stairwell) should be investigated to determine the source and path of water infiltration and repairs made to prevent any further leaking.

Based on observations made, four directives are being issued.



they are used or intended.

The employer shall make a list of all areas where active leaks take place and provide the undersigned with an action plan, including timelines, detailing what is to be done to address the leaks.


