## VERBATIM REPORT

Monday, August 21, 1972

The House met at 3:00 P.M., Mr. Speaker in the Chair.

MR. MARSHALL: Mr. Speaker, before we get to presenting petitions,
the House is meeting today for the purpose of adjourning and I
would like to bring in a motion of adjournment until later on
in the fall, the date to be November 27. I will make the formal
notice now in a moment.

I might indicate that the date has been set forth far enough ahead in the fall with the object being that if it is necessary, and it may well be necessary, the House can be reconvened again at the call of the Chair. The purpose of this adjournment then, even though the day is November 27, the adjournment should really be considered as an adjournment to the call of the Chair, so then, Mr. Speaker, I move that when the House adjourned today, and it now adjourn, it stand adjourned until Monday, November 27, 1972 at 3:00 P.M., provided always that if it appears to the satisfaction of Mr. Speaker, or in the case of his absence from the province, the Chairman of Committees, after consultation with Her Majesty's Government, that the public interest requires that the House should meet at an earlier time than the adjournment, Mr. Speaker, or in his absence the Chairman of Committees, may give notice that he is so satisfied and there upon the House shall meet at the time stated by such notice and shall transact its business as if it had been duly adjourned to that time.

I would move that motion, Mr. Speaker.

On motion that the House at its rising adjourn until tomorrow Monday, November 27, 1972.
