On Friday, May 25th at 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon the Honourable the Speaker (Mr. Hodder) and the Clerk of the House of Assembly attended upon the Honourable Edward Roberts, Q.C., Lieutenant Governor of Newfoundland and Labrador at Government House.

A Bill, "An Act to Amend The Public Service Pensions Act" (Bill No. 5);

A Bill, "An Act To Amend The Transfer Of Securities" (Bill No. 8);

A Bill, "An Act To Amend The Internal Economy Commission Act" (Bill No. 11);

A Bill, "An Act To Amend The Pension Benefits Act" (Bill No.15);

A Bill, "An Act To Amend The Public Service Pensions Act, 1991, The Teachers' Pensions Act And The Uniformed Services Pensions Act, 1991" (Bill No. 16).

His Honour the Lieutenant Governor then said, "In Her Majesty's Name, I Assent to these Bills".
