On Thursday, December 18th, 2008 at 11:30 o'clock in the morning the Honourable the Speaker (Mr. Fitzgerald) and the Clerk of the House of Assembly attended upon the Honourable John C. Crosbie, P.C., O.C., O.N.L., Q.C., Lieutenant Governor of Newfoundland and Labrador at Government House.

The Speaker addressed His Honour as follows:

“It is my agreeable duty on behalf of Her Majesty’s dutiful and loyal subjects, Her Faithful Commons in Newfoundland and Labrador, to present to Your Honour a Bill for the appropriation of Supplementary Supply granted in the present Session.”
