The Honourable the Minister of Transportation & Works (Mr. Hedderson) made a Statement to inform the House of the delivery of the first of four Bombardier 415 waterbombers which the Government has purchased.

The Honourable the Minister of Justice & Attorney General (Mr. Collins) made a Statement to inform the House about his visit to the North Coast of Labrador.
