The Member for Lewisporte (Mr. Verge) made a Statement to pay tribute to his wife, Maxine Verge, who is a cancer patient and to recognize all cancer patients in the Province.

By leave, the Member for Grand Falls – Windsor – Buchans (Ms. Sullivan) made a Statement to congratulate Ms. Françoise Enguehard who has received the “Prix des lecteurs” from Radio-Canada.

The Honourable the Minister of Business (Mr. Wiseman) made a Statement about Business activity and economic growth in the Province.

The Member for Exploits (Mr. Forsey) tabled the Report of the Government Services Committee.
