The Member for Mount Pearl South (Mr. Lane) made a Statement to congratulate and thank the volunteers who administer the Shepherd's Café programme at the Parish of the Good Shepherd in Mount Pearl for the work they do.

A Bill, "An Act To Amend The Public Service Collective Bargaining Act No. 2" (Bill No. 38).
