On motion it was ordered that the said Bill be printed being entitled as above and that it be submitted to His Honour the Lieutenant Governor for his Assent.

Pursuant to order and on motion debate continued and concluded on Second Reading of a Bill entitled "An Act To Amend The Electrical Power Control Act, 1994, The Energy Corporation Act And the Hydro Corporation Act, 2007" (Bill No. 61) and on motion it was ordered that Bill No. 61 be now read the second time.

Pursuant to order and on motion debate continued and concluded on Second Reading of a Bill entitled "An Act Respecting The Use And Expropriation Of Land For The Purpose Of The Muskrat Falls Project" (Bill No. 60) and on motion it was ordered that Bill No. 60 be now read the second time.

Pursuant to order and on motion the Bill entitled "An Act Respecting The Use And Expropriation Of Land For The Purpose Of The Muskrat Falls Project" (Bill No. 60) was read the second time and on motion it was ordered that Bill No. 60 be referred to a Committee of the Whole House now.

On motion of the Honourable the Government House Leader (Mr. King) the House resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole House.

The Speaker left the Chair. Mr. Verge took the Chair of Committee of the Whole House.

By leave, the proceedings were suspended at 5:30 o'clock in the afternoon for the dinner break.

The Deputy Chair of Committees (Mr. Littlejohn) resumed the Chair at 7:00 o'clock in the evening.

On motion the Committee rose.

The Speaker resumed the Chair.

The Chairperson of the Committee of the Whole House (Mr. Littlejohn) reported that the Committee of the Whole House had considered the matters to them referred and had directed him to report that they had made some progress in their consideration of a Bill entitled "An Act Respecting The Use And Expropriation Of Land For The Purpose Of The Muskrat Falls Project" (Bill No. 60) and a Bill entitled "An Act To Amend The Electrical Power Control Act, 1994, The Energy Corporation Act And the Hydro Corporation Act, 2007" (Bill No. 61) and ask leave to sit again.

On motion the report of the Committee of the Whole House was received and adopted.
