The Member for Bonavista North (Mr. Cross) made a Statement to recognize the organizers, volunteers and chaperones who make possible the activities of the Bonavista North Polar Bears Special Olympics athletes.

The Member for St. John's West (Mr. Crummell) made a Statement to recognize St. Matthew Elementary Schools' After School Physical Activities Programme.

The Member for The Straits – White Bay North (Mr. Mitchelmore) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to commit to bridge funding in its 2013 budget to help preserve RED Boards in Newfoundland and Labrador.

The Member for St. John's East (Mr. Murphy) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to impose a moratorium on slickwater fracking until they develop regulations and ensure each project undergoes a conclusive environmental assessment.
