Administration of the Oath or Affirmation of Office to Members-elect

AND

The Election of the Speaker of the House of Assembly

Begun and holden at St. John's in the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador on Friday, the Eighteenth Day of December, Two Thousand and Fifteen, being the Sixty-Fourth year of the Reign of Her Majesty Our Sovereign Lady Elizabeth the Second by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom, Canada, and Her Other Realms and Territories, QUEEN, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith.

In accordance with the **Elections Act, 1991**, a General Election was held on the 30th day of November, 2015 after which His Honour, the Honourable Frank F. Fagan, CM, ONL, MBA, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador issued the following Proclamation:

A PROCLAMATION

NOW THEREFORE I, the Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do authorize and direct you, the said Sandra Barnes and Elizabeth Murphy, or either of you, to request that the Members Elect gather in the House of Assembly Chamber on Friday, December 18th, 2015 at 10 o'clock in the morning in order to take their Oaths or Affirmations of Allegiance and Oaths or Affirmations of Office before me.

Whereupon His Honour the Lieutenant Governor left the Chamber.

The Clerk informed the Members that at the close of nominations on Thursday, December 17th, Mr. Tom Osborne and Mr. Scott Reid had informed the Clerk of their intention to stand for election to the Office of Speaker.

Accordingly, pursuant to Standing Order 2, at 2:00 o'clock the House proceeded to the election of the Speaker.

At 2:20 o'clock the voting procedure was completed and the sitting was suspended to the call of the Chair for the counting of the ballots by the Clerks-at-the-Table.

At 2:35 o'clock the sitting resumed.

Pursuant to Standing Suborder 4(11) the Clerk announced that the Member for the District of Waterford Valley, Mr. Tom Osborne had been elected as Speaker.

Mr. Osborne was conducted to the Speaker's Chair by the Honourable the Premier (Mr. Ball) and the Opposition House Leader (Mr. Hutchings).

Whereupon, the Honourable the Speaker having seated himself in the Speaker's Chair addressed the House, expressing his gratitude to the Honourable Members for the high honour they had unanimously accorded him by electing him Speaker of the House of Assembly.

On motion of the Honourable the Premier (Mr. Ball), seconded by the Opposition House Leader (Mr. Hutchings), the Member for Cartwright – L'Anse au Clair (Ms. Dempster) was elected Deputy Speaker of the House.

On motion of the Honourable the Premier (Mr. Ball), seconded by the Opposition House Leader (Mr. Hutchings), the Member for Mount Pearl – Southlands (Mr. Lane) was elected Deputy Chair of Committees.

The House adjourned at 2:47 o'clock in the afternoon sine die.
