The House met at 1:30 o'clock in the afternoon pursuant to adjournment.

The Member for Stephenville – Port au Port (Mr. Finn) made a Statement to congratulate Ryan McNeil-Lamswood who was named the Fair Play skip of the National Under-18 Curling Championship.

The Member for Labrador West (Mr. Letto) made a Statement to congratulate Gail Hodge, Brad Dillon and associates on the production of their educational documentary, about Ewing's Sarcoma, called Make It Stop, which has been incorporated into the College of Family Physicians of Canada's self-learning module.

The Member for Terra Nova (Mr. Holloway) made a Statement to congratulate Herder Memorial Trophy Winners, the Clarenville Ford Caribous and coach Rebecca Russell.

The Member for Ferryland (Mr. Hutchings) made a Statement to congratulate Liam O'Brien, who has been awarded a Loran Scholarship, on his many accomplishments and wish him well in the future.

The Member for Bonavista (Mr. King) made a Statement to congratulate Voluntary Organizations in Community Engagement (VOICE) on their 10th anniversary and recognize all volunteers for their contribution to their communities.
