

Thursday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018

The House met at 1:30 o'clock in the afternoon pursuant to adjournment.

The Member for Cape St. Francis (Mr. Parsons) made a Statement to congratulate Mrs. Mary Fleming who had celebrated her 100<sup>th</sup> birthday on November 16<sup>th</sup>.

The Member for Humber – Bay of Islands (Mr. Joyce) made a Statement to congratulate Jamie Brake who has received Recreation Newfoundland and Labrador's Volunteer of the Year Award and NAPE's Community Volunteer Step Up Award.

The Member for Bonavista (Mr. King) made a Statement to recognize Frances Sweetland for her life long commitment to the Guiding Movement.

The Member for Mount Pearl – Southlands (Mr. Lane) made a Statement to commend the Mount Pearl Minor Hockey Association and other Mount Pearl organizations which will be participating in the Associations 7<sup>th</sup> Annual "Big Give Food Drive".

The Honourable the Minister of Transportation and Works (Mr. Crocker) made a Statement to inform the House about the 26<sup>th</sup> Annual National Conference on Public Private Partnerships which he had attended.

The Honourable the Minister of Health and Community Services (Mr. Haggie) made a Statement to recognize November 12<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> as World Antibiotic Awareness Week.

The Honourable the Minister of Service NL (Ms. Gambin-Walsh) gave notice that she would on tomorrow ask leave to introduce a Bill entitled "An Act To Amend The Highway Traffic Act No. 2" (Bill No. 39).

The Honourable the Minister Responsible for the Newfoundland and Labrador Housing Corporation (Ms. Dempster) gave notice that she would on tomorrow ask leave to introduce a Bill entitled "An Act To Amend The Housing Corporation Act" (Bill No. 40).

The Honourable the Minister of Natural Resources (Ms. Coady) gave the answer to a question for which notice had been given regarding Astaldi.

The Member for Mount Pearl – Southlands – (Mr. Lane) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to disclose all the potential options for power rate mitigation and develop and make public a plan to deal with power rate increases.

Pursuant to order and on motion the following Bills were read the third time and passed:

A Bill,            “An Act Respecting The Protection Of Intimate Images” (Bill No. 12);

A Bill,            “An Act To Amend The Assessment Act, 2006” (Bill No. 34).

On motion it was ordered that the said Bills be printed being entitled as above and that they be submitted to Her Honour the Lieutenant Governor for her assent.

Pursuant to order and on motion debate commenced and concluded on Third Reading of a Bill entitled “An Act To Amend The Labour Standards Act” (Bill No. 32) and on motion the Bill was read the third time and passed.

On motion it was ordered that the said Bill be printed being entitled as above and that it be submitted to Her Honour the Lieutenant Governor for her assent.

Pursuant to notice and on motion the House adopted the following Resolution standing in the name of the Honourable the Government House Leader (Mr. Parsons):

**“BE IT RESOLVED** that the Member for the District of Harbour Grace – Port de Grave be appointed Deputy Chair of Committees for the remainder of the Forty-Eighth General Assembly”.

The Speaker put the question and declared the Resolution carried.

Pursuant to order and on motion debate commenced and concluded on Second Reading of a Bill entitled “An Act To Amend The Workplace Health, Safety And Compensation Act No. 2” (Bill No. 36) and on motion it was ordered that Bill No. 36 be now read the second time.

Pursuant to order and on motion the Bill entitled “An Act To Amend The Workplace Health, Safety And Compensation Act No. 2” (Bill No. 36) was read the second time and on motion it was ordered that Bill No. 36 be referred to a Committee of the Whole now.

On motion of the Honourable the Government House Leader (Mr. Parsons) the House resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole House to consider a Bill entitled “An Act To Amend The Workplace Health, Safety And Compensation Act No. 2” (Bill No. 36).

On motion the report of the Committee was received and adopted.

On motion it was ordered that Bill No. 36 be read the third time on tomorrow.

Pursuant to notice and on motion debate continued on the following Resolution standing in the name of the Honourable the Government House Leader (Mr. Parsons):

**"BE IT RESOLVED** that the House of Assembly urge the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador to establish an all-party Select Committee on Democratic Reform."

On motion debate was adjourned for further debate on tomorrow.

It was moved and seconded that when the House rose it would adjourn until tomorrow, Monday, November 19<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 o'clock in the afternoon.

On motion the House then adjourned accordingly.
