INTRASESSIONAL PROCEEDING

At 11:30 a.m., the Honourable the Speaker (D. Bennett) and the Clerk of the House of Assembly appeared before the Administrator, the Honourable Deborah E. Fry, Chief Justice of Newfoundland and Labrador, at the Court of Appeal.

The Speaker addressed the Administrator as follows:

“May it please the Honourable Administrator, the General Assembly of the Province has at its present Session passed several bills, to which, in the name and on behalf of the General Assembly, I respectfully request your assent.”

Whereupon the Clerk read the following bills:

- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Medical Act, 2011” (Bill 1);
- A bill, “An Act for Granting to His Majesty Certain Sums of Money for Defraying Certain Additional Expenses of the Public Service for the Financial Year Ending March 31, 2023 and for Other Purposes Relating to the Public Service” (Bill 2);
- A bill, “An Act Respecting Pay Equity for the Public Sector and Pay Transparency for the Public and Private Sectors” (Bill 3);
- A bill, “An Act Respecting the Establishment of the Newfoundland and Labrador Future Fund” (Bill 5);
- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Revenue Administration Act” (Bill 6);
- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Schools Act, 1997” (Bill 7);
- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Credit Union Act, 2009” (Bill 8);
- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Highway Traffic Act” (Bill 9);
- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Wild Life Act” (Bill 10);
- A bill, “An Act Respecting the Winding Up of Judgment Recovery (NFLD.) Ltd.” (Bill 11);

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- A bill, “An Act Respecting the Workplace Health, Safety and Compensation Act” (Bill 12);
- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Consumer Protection and Business Practices Act” (Bill 13);
- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Real Estate Trading Act, 2019” (Bill 14);
- A bill, “An Act to Ensure Fair Registration Practices by Regulating Bodies” (Bill 15);
- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Revenue Administration Act No. 2” (Bill 16);
- A bill, “An Act Respecting the Health and Safety of Workers and the Compensation of Workers for Injuries Suffered in the Course of Their Employment” (Bill 18);
- A bill, “An Act to Amend the Fishing Industry Collective Bargaining Act” (Bill 19); and
- A bill, “An Act Respecting the Delivery of Health and Community Services and the Establishment of a Provincial Health Authority” (Bill 20).

The Administrator then said, “In His Majesty’s Name, I assent to these bills.”
