HUMBER EAST

On Monday, November 3, 2014, a Writ of Election was issued for a by-election in the electoral district of Humber East. The by-election, set for Tuesday, November 25, 2014, was called to fill a vacancy resulting from the resignation of Progressive Conservative Member of the House of Assembly, Tom Marshall on Monday, November 3, 2014.

The preliminary list of electors for the district, dated November 3, 2014, contained 7869 names. Updates to the list continued during the election period until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 18, 2014 (Advance Poll day), resulting in a final revised list of electors containing 8027 names. The final revised list included electors who applied to vote by Special Ballot, voted at the advance polls and applied to be added to the list (and also included other changes such as elector moves or corrections to electors' names and/or addresses).

On Thursday, November 20, 2014, the final revised list was given to the district Returning Officer for distribution to the political parties and candidates. This list was used by the Returning Officer and all election officials as the Official List of Electors on polling day.

Official Nomination day was Saturday, November 15, 2014. At the close of nominations three candidates had completed the official nomination process and were added to the ballot for the by-election:

Stelman Flynn – Liberal Party
Martin Ware – New Democratic Party
Lary Wells – Progressive Conservative Party

Voters in the by-election had the opportunity to vote by one of three methods:

- at one of the 31 regular polls held on November 25, 2014
- at one of the three advance polls held on November 18, 2014
- by Special Ballot (from November 4, 2014 to November 18, 2014)

Special Ballot applications were available on the Elections Newfoundland and Labrador website, by mail, or during specified hours at Elections Newfoundland and Labrador's head office in St. John's or the District Returning Office in Humber East. Once a Special Ballot application was approved, a Special Ballot voting kit was issued, and the applicant was then unable to vote by any other method. A completed Special Ballot voting kit could be returned by mail or dropped off at either of the above noted office locations within the specified deadlines.

- A total of 252 Special Ballot applications were processed at Special Ballot locations. Of the 252 applications processed, all 252 ballots were returned by the specified deadlines.
- A total of 551 ballots were cast at the three advance polls held on November 18, 2014.
- A total of 3182 ballots were cast at the 31 regular polls held on November 25, 2014.
- A combined total of 606 electors were sworn in at the advance polls, Special Ballot polls and regular polls on polling day.

The preliminary count on election night indicated a total of 4032 votes were cast resulting in 2263 votes for Stelman Flynn, 315 votes for Martin Ware and 1454 votes for Lary Wells.

The official addition of the votes took place on Friday, November 28, 2014 at the district Returning Office which resulted in a decrease of 63 votes for Mr. Stelman Flynn from the preliminary vote count reported on election night. Therefore, the official results for the by-election (which represented a 49.64 per cent turnout) of registered voters were:

The by-election, set for Tuesday, November 25, 2014, was called to fill a vacancy resulting from the resignation of Progressive Conservative Member of the House of Assembly, Charlene Johnson on Friday, September 5, 2014.

The preliminary list of electors for the district, dated October 6, 2014, contained 6717 names. Updates to the list continued during the election period until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 18, 2014 (Advance Poll day), resulting in a final revised list of electors containing 6788 names. The final revised list included electors who applied to vote by Special Ballot, voted at the advance polls and applied to be added to the list (and also included other changes such as elector moves or corrections to electors' names and/or addresses).

On Thursday, November 20, 2014, the final revised list was given to the district Returning Officer for distribution to the political parties and candidates. This list was used by the Returning Officer and all election officials as the Official List of Electors on polling day.

Official Nomination day was Saturday, November 15, 2014. At the close of nominations three candidates had completed the official nomination process and were added to the ballot for the by-election:

Steve Crocker – Liberal Party
Ronald Johnson – Progressive Conservative Party
Tolson Rendell – New Democratic Party

- A total of 240 Special Ballot applications were processed at Special Ballot locations. Of the 240 applications processed, 229 ballots were returned by the specified deadlines.
- A total of 225 ballots were cast at the four advance polls held on November 18, 2014. Fifty-one ballots were cast at the advance poll in Old Perlican, 36 ballots were cast at the advance poll in New Perlican, 92 ballots were cast at the advance poll in Burnt Point and 46 ballots were cast at the advance poll in Green's Harbour.
- A total of 4197 ballots were cast at the 36 regular polls held on November 25, 2014.
