**Table Questions in the House of Assembly from MHA Keith Hutchings**

**Question 6:**

The total amount of provincial revenue generated from Corporate Income Tax. If up-to-date data is not available, please provide the most recent total possible.

- a) The total amount of provincial revenue generated from Corporate Income Tax in 2015-16 fiscal for the same period as in the question above.

**Response:**

Mr. Speaker, on March 15, 2017, the member opposite (MHA Hutchings) tabled the following question in this House:

The total amount of provincial revenue generated from Corporate Income Tax. If up-to-date data is not available, please provide the most recent total possible.

- b) The total amount of provincial revenue generated from Corporate Income Tax in 2015-16 fiscal for the same period as in the question above.

Mr. Speaker, corporate Income Tax 2016-17 cash revenue to the end of February 2017 is \$222,288,268.

It is important to note - this figure is cash revenue only, as recorded in Government Accounting's Oracle financial system and excludes any provincially-administered rebates that are charged against Corporate Income Tax.

The difference in cash revenue would be a result of any changes to the tax system/rates, changes in tax filer base, changes in individual taxpayer circumstances and any prior period adjustments.

In addition, corporate Income Tax 2015-16 cash revenue to the end of February 2016 is \$316,067,876.

Please note - this figure is cash revenue only, as recorded in Government Accounting's Oracle financial system and excludes any provincially-administered rebates that are charged against Corporate Income Tax.

The difference in cash revenue would be a result of any changes to the tax system/rates, changes in tax filer base, changes in individual taxpayer circumstances and any prior period adjustments.
