Question 5:

The total amount of provincial revenue generated in this fiscal year (to date) 2016-17 from the Gasoline Tax. If up-to-date data is not available, please provide the most recent total possible.

- a) The total amount of provincial revenue generated from the Gasoline Tax in 2015-16 fiscal year for the same period as found in the question above.

Response:

Mr. Speaker, on.....the member opposite (MHA Hutchings) tabled the following question in this House:

The total amount of provincial revenue generated in this fiscal year (to date) 2016-17 from the Gasoline Tax. If up-to-date data is not available, please provide the most recent total possible.

- a) The total amount of provincial revenue generated from the Gasoline Tax in 2015-16 fiscal year for the same period as found in the question above.

Mr. Speaker, gasoline Tax 2016-17 cash revenue to the end of February 2017 is \$274,183,321.

It is important to note - this figure is cash revenue only, as recorded in Government Account's Oracle financial system and excludes any provincial-administered rebates that are charged against gasoline.

The difference in cash revenue would be a result of any changes to the tax system/rates, changes in the consumer tax base, as well as changes in consumption.

In addition, gasoline Tax 2015-16 cash revenue to the end of February 2016 is \$180,796,682.

Please note - this figure is cash revenue only, as recorded in Government Account's Oracle financial system and excludes any provincial-administered rebates that are charged against gasoline.

The difference in cash revenue would be a result of any changes to the tax system/rates, changes in the consumer tax base, as well as changes in consumption.
