On Monday, November 4, 2013, a Writ of Election was issued for a by-election in the electoral district of Carbonear – Harbour Grace. The by-election, set for November 26, 2013, was called to fill a vacancy resulting from the resignation of Progressive Conservative Member of the House of Assembly, Jerome Kennedy, on October 2, 2013.

The preliminary list of electors for the district, dated November 4, 2013, contained 8955 names. Updates to the list continued during the election period until 8 p.m. on November 19, 2013 (Advance Poll day), resulting in a final revised list of electors containing 9140 names. The final revised list included electors who applied to vote by Special Ballot, voted at the advance polls and applied to be added to the list (and also included other changes such as elector moves or corrections to electors' names and/or addresses).

On November 20, 2013, the final revised list was given to the district Returning Officer for distribution to the political parties and candidates. This list was used by the Returning Officer and all election officials as the Official List of Electors on polling day.

Official Nomination day was Saturday, November 16, 2013. At the close of nominations three candidates had completed the official nomination process and were added to the ballot for the by-election:

Jack Harrington - Progressive Conservative Party Sam Slade - Liberal Party Charlene Sudbrink - New Democratic Party

Voters in the by-election had the opportunity to vote by one of three methods:

- at one of the 36 regular polls held on November 26, 2013
- at one of the four advance polls held on November 19, 2013
- by Special Ballot (from November 4, 2013 to November 22, 2013)

Special Ballot applications were available on the Elections Newfoundland and Labrador website, by mail, or during specified hours at Elections Newfoundland and Labrador's head office in St. John's or the District Returning Office in Carbonear-Harbour Grace. Once a Special Ballot application was approved, a Special Ballot Voting kit was issued, and the applicant was then unable to vote by any other method. A completed Special Ballot voting kit could be returned by mail or dropped off at either of the above noted office locations within the specified deadlines.

A total of 267 Special Ballot applications were processed at Special Ballot locations. Of the 267 applications processed, all 267 ballots were returned by the specified deadlines.

A total of 776 ballots were cast at the four advance polls held on November 19, 2013. 530 ballots were cast at the two advance polls in Carbonear, and 246 ballots were cast at the two advance polls in Harbour Grace.

A total of 4732 ballots were cast at the 36 regular polls held on November 26, 2013.

A combined total of 609 electors were sworn in at the advance polls, Special Ballot polls and regular polls on polling day.

The preliminary count on election night indicated a total of 5492 votes were cast resulting in 2313 votes for Jack Harrington, 2769 votes for Sam Slade and 410 votes for Charlene Sudbrink.

The official addition of the votes took place on Friday, November 29, 2013, at the district Returning Office which confirmed the preliminary vote counts were correct for all candidates. Therefore, the official results for the by-election (which represented a 60.3 per cent turnout) were:

On December 11, 2013, Liberal candidate Sam Slade was sworn in as a member of the House of Assembly.

Subsequent to the by-election and prior to the completion of this report, representation in the House of Assembly changed as follows:

- On January 20, 2014, Mount Pearl South MHA Paul Lane, who had been sitting as a Progressive Conservative in the House of Assembly, announced his decision to join the Liberal Party.
- On February 4, 2014, Dale Kirby and Christopher Mitchelmore, sitting as independent members since October 29, 2013, joined the Liberal Party.
- On February 28, 2014, Virginia Waters MHA and former Premier Kathy Dunderdale, who had been sitting as a Progressive Conservative in the House of Assembly, resigned her seat.

Currently, representation in the House of Assembly consists of 33 Progressive Conservative Members, 11 Liberal Members, 3 New Democratic Members, and 1 vacant seat.

The Chief Electoral Officer would like to extend appreciation to the district staff for overseeing an efficient by-election: Debbie Reynolds (Returning Officer), Linda Murphy (Election Clerk) and Ruth Colbourne (Special Ballot Officer). Thanks are also extended to the many other district election workers and to the staff at the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer for a job well done.
