*NOTE*- An additional $\mathbf{\$ 1 8 . 2}$ million is generated from wood energy (not in above table) that would increase the total industry value to $\$ 304.7$ million. Wood energy includes commercial firewood, wood pellet, and briquette sales. Employees working in the wood energy sector are already included in other sectors, hence no additional employment.
*NOTE* - Approximately 450 government employees (not included in above table) work in support of the forest industry.
