The Private Industry Air Access Advisory Committee provides advice to the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador on matters related to air access and in support of the government's five year strategy which was launched in 2010. Taking Flight - An Air Access Strategy for Newfoundland and Labrador provides a planned and coordinated framework for improving air access in the province and sets out an approach to resolving the issues of flight availability and capacity at Newfoundland and Labrador airports.
