As required by the *House of Assembly Accountability, Integrity and Administration Act*, the Speaker reported a Decision made at an *in camera* meeting on February 13, 2018:

The Commission, at an *in camera* meeting, approved the 2018-2019 estimates for the Legislature, to be forwarded to the Minister of Finance for inclusion in the 2018 Estimates and voted on in the Legislature.

CM 2018-008 The Commission, at an *in-camera* meeting, approved a one-time funding request as part of the 2018-2019 estimates for the Office of the Child and Youth Advocate, to be forwarded to the Minister of Finance for inclusion in the 2018 Estimates and voted on in the Legislature. The Commission also waived the 2-day waiting period for this decision to expedite provision of the information to the Department of Finance in advance of Budget 2018. CM 2018-009 The Minutes of the Management Commission meeting held on February 1, 2018 were approved as read.

CM 2018-010 The Commission approved the payment of expenses totaling \$490.00 and \$1,333.40 for the Member for Lake Melville.

CM 2018-011 The Commission deferred a decision with respect to appeals for the Member for Cape St. Francis and the Member for Conception Bay East-Bell Island pending further analysis to be brought back to the Commission for consideration at a future meeting.

- **CM 2018-012** The Commission approved the Office of the Seniors' Advocate as a Category 3 entity for the purposes of applying the *Transparency and Accountability Act*, as recommended in the categorization assessment form dated March 1, 2018.
- CM 2018-013 The Commission approved the expenditure to install video security intercoms with door releases for the constituency offices located in leased premises.
- CM 2018-014 The Commission did not approve the request from the Member for Mount Pearl-Southlands to allow replacement Members for meetings of the Management Commission. The current provisions of the *House of Assembly Accountability, Integrity* and Administration Act, prohibiting alternate members will continue.
